

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. Do I need to apply for this scholarship?** No. This is an automatic scholarship provided by the department for declaring petroleum engineering, geological engineering, or geology and geophysics.
- 2. How is this scholarship distributed?**
  - a. First time students:** \$1,000 start of Fall 2024 semester, \$1,000 start of Spring 2025 semester, and \$2,000 start of Fall 2026 semester (junior year). Funds will be transferred into your student account.
  - b. Undergraduate initial transfer students:** \$2,000 start of Fall 2024 semester, \$2,000 start of Spring 2025 semester (junior year). Funds will be transferred into your student account.
- 3. I'm a current S&T student. Am I eligible to receive this scholarship if I transfer into one petroleum engineering, geological engineering, or geology and geophysics?** No. This scholarship is for initial transfer students into the undergraduate program.
- 4. What are eligibility requirements to receive this scholarship?** You must be enrolled full time (12 credit hours) in the petroleum engineering, geological engineering, or geology and geophysics program at Missouri S&T. Domestic and international are eligible.
- 5. Do graduate students qualify to receive this scholarship?** No. This scholarship is for first time students attending Missouri S&T as their first college post high school. This scholarship is also available to undergraduate students during their initial transfer into Missouri S&T.
